Ancient Greece (Summer 1)
The children will be examining Greek artefacts and using these to make inferences about the past, describing what they tell us about their culture, military, and religious beliefs. We will be looking at the impact of Greek society on the modern world, for example democracy. The children will examine the timeline of Ancient Greece, considering the changes. We will also be learning about Greek Gods and Philosophers.

We learn a new song or musical game every week. We sing the songs as a class, in small groups and on our own. We are working with crotchets, quavers, rests and semiquaver rhythms which we can read and compose with. We are beginning to sing in parts.
